Program Overview:

- 3 full time radiologists and one part-time online radiologist residency director
- On-site 3T Philips Achieva MRI, 128-slice Philips Incisive CT, RS80 Samsung ultrasound machines with cardiology package.
- Nuclear medicine program (scintigraphy, I-131, and Synovetin OA)
- Close collaboration with other specialists, including internists, surgeons and pathologists
- Rounds, KCC, mock exams, and online radiology content program
- Academic affiliation for large animal training
- Currently a 3-yr program but possibility of 4-yr residency program
- High case-load provides a wide range of practical experience

Compensation and Benefits:

- \$35-\$45k/year salary
- Eligible for full medical benefits (health, vision, dental, etc.)
